 - Forecast volumes of traffic


- Diversion Route as discussed with BC

- This includes Fusion vehicles


Route name: West Street Compound, Edgcott route.

• 39 HGV (78 movements) per day


Note: This route is currently not being used as the Schedule 17 Lorry Route has not been approved.
