- Test Piles: mobilisation, preparation and pile testing
- Abnormal Load Route Traffic Management: Slow moving abnormal load
- Calvert South Site Clearance: temporary fencing, devegetation and GPR



Calvert South – Construction Route

Rationale:

- Weak structure advisory weight limit imposed on Fidlers Field and Station Road
- Construction vehicles exceed imposed weight limits
- Alternative routes presented to HS2 and Buckinghamshire Council for consideration
- Safest route selected


Construction route:

- M40 Junction 9
- A41
- Grendon Underwood
- Edgcott
- Calvert Green
- Botolph Claydon

Restricted traffic to 10 days or less, East Claydon Parish Council engaged and informed.

Abnormal Load route:

- M40 or A41
- Quainton







Fusion

- Station Road South Upgrade: Phase 1 material deliveries and surveys. Phase 2 - utility diversion, utility protection and passing bays
- Station Road Traffic Management: Phase 1 Daytime week day (7:00am to 5:00pm, Mon to Fri) road colure from 19th to 23rd October. Phase 2 - Full road closure 9:00am Mon through to 7:00am Sat, starting 26th Oct to 19th Dec 2020
- A41 Traffic Management: 2-way lights for night-time working (6:30pm to 6:30am Monday nights to Friday nights) until 19th December 2020


- (SGN) Diverted Gas Pipeline: dewatering & drying diverted gas pipeline, tie-in to and commission
- (SGN) Quainton Road Traffic Management: 2-way lights early December

EKFB

- Utilities Survey: GPR survey works for trial holes, trial holes & boreholes and TM 2-way lights
- Station Road Compound: site clearance & temporary fencing

Emergency repair works to weak bridge



Station Road & A41 – 1st Dec 2020 to 31st Jan 2021

Fusion

- Station Road South Upgrade: Phase 2 highway resurfacing, highway furniture and landscaping
- Station Road Traffic Management: Phase 2 Full road closure 9:00am Mon through to 7:00am Sat, until 19th Dec 2020. <u>Christmas period embargo, Station Road re-opens temporarily</u> <u>during 19th Dec 7:00am to early Jan.</u>
- Station Road / A41 Junction Upgrade: utilities diversion and junction widening
- A41 Traffic Management: 2-way lights for night-time working (6:30pm to 6:30am Mondays nights to Saturday nights) until 19th December 2020.

HS₂

- (SGN) Diverted Gas Pipeline: Finish works
- (SGN) Quainton Road Traffic Management: 2-way lights until early December

EKFB

- Utilities Diversion with associated Traffic Management: details being developed for Station Road and Fidlers Field
- Station Road Compound: site clearance, temporary fencing, utilities, base construction, welfare units & ancillary works

- Station Road / A41 Junction Upgrade: Phase 3 junction widening, services & pavement




Vehicle Management

HS2 HELPDESK
What is it and how do I use it?



HS2 Helpdesk


- Complaints team has been in place for nearly 3 years with an established process
- From the 1st of April 2019 the HS2 Helpdesk has been delivered by a new internationally renowned customer service provider
- The team are based within the Community Hub in Snow Hill between 7am and 7pm Monday-Friday (in normal circumstances) and therefore the team can resolve issues much more promptly by working closely with specialist teams across HS2
- The Helpdesk are open 24/7 and 365 days a year
- There is also a permanent out of hours presence in the office available to support communities any hour of the day as issues arise
- The team manage in excess of 35,000 enquiries and complaints per annum and evidence suggests this is rising year on year
- 60 % of enquiries are via email and 40% enquiries are received by telephone call







What is the helpdesk?



- The Helpdesk will resolve higher volume, lower complexity enquiries and will undertake simple assessments based on a clear set of eligibility criteria.
- HS2 back office specialists are responsible for resolving detailed technical enquiries/ undertaking complex assessments.
- IPT teams & Compliance teams are responsible for resolving detailed technical enquiries and enacting operational fixes.
- HS2 need to record and log our interactions and share them in a way that is compliant – that means we are on the front foot with our interactions with people and we know their previous dealings with us
