Dear resident of Calvert Green,

Calvert Green Parish Council are currently developing a Neighbourhood Plan. This is a community-led planning document which will guide future development, regeneration and conservation within the Parish of Calvert Green and **YOUR** contribution is vitally important!

In accordance with the guidelines, a Steering Group (made up of Calvert residents, the Calvert Green Community Association and Parish Council members), is being formed to take the process forward for Calvert Green Parish. The Steering Group's aim will be to consult with as many residents and homeowners as possible, to create a valid "desires" profile of the community in all its aspects.

Responses to this questionnaire will provide us with the community's views. The responses will be analysed and used to create a "desires" profile document, which subsequently will be distributed to the community. An application for approval to proceed will then be made to Buckinghamshire Unitary Council. If they approve, the results will be used in the preparation of a draft Neighbourhood Plan. Following final consultation with the community, this will be presented to the District Council for adoption.

Your input as a resident is key to the development of this plan. It will help us share your vision and shape the future and growth of our village. It will also give you a greater say in the development of our local area.

Developing a Neighbourhood Plan is a new legal right giving our Parish community direct power to develop a shared vision for the Parish and shape its development and growth for the next 20 years. While the Neighbourhood Plan can only be written about land use issues that can be affected through the planning system and planning application, we are taking the opportunity in this questionnaire to also ask your opinion on a number of issues that affect daily life in the Parish as we believe it will provide valuable information to enhance living in Calvert Green Parish for years to come!

Why is a Neighbourhood plan important to You..

Having a Neighbourhood Plan allows a community to get the development needed for their area. It deals with a wide range of social, economic and environmental issues, such as housing, employment, heritage and transport. When completed it will form part of the statutory planning policy for the Parish alongside the Joint Local Plan. It is only with the full involvement of all our community that we can get a clear vision of what the community wants, in order to reflect your needs in our Neighbourhood Plan.

Central to the Neighbourhood Planning process is public engagement and consultation – and this questionnaire, which is going out to every household in the Parish, is one of the cornerstones of that consultation process.
